

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

STATEMENT OF INTENT



Watermark Systems UK Ltd believes that the health, safety and welfare of their employees is of prime importance and essential for the efficient operation of its undertakings. Equally, it is the duty of each and every employee to assist the organisation in the attainment of its Health and Safety objectives. The organisation expects employees to take reasonable care of their own health, safety and welfare and that of others who may be affected by their actions.

Overall responsibility for the health, safety and welfare of the organisation and its personnel is vested in the named Managing Director.

In its commitment to prevent injury and ill health to employees, contractors and others affected by day-to-day operations, and in striving for continual improvement, the company sets annual objectives and targets against which its performance is monitored.

Management will give full support to all those who endeavour to carry out this policy.
